



Mystery Monday Stamping

CLUE #1

1. Designer Series Paper – 1" x 5 1/4"
2. Colored Cardstock – 5 1/2" x 8 1/2", scored at 4 1/4"
3. Same Colored Cardstock – 1/2" x 5 1/4"
4. Basic White Cardstock – (2) 4" x 5 1/4"
5. Sentiment stamp
6. Circle Punch or Dies to fit Sentiment Stamp
7. If you don't have circle punches or dies, have your Paper Trimmer handy
8. Scrap Basic White
9. Scrap color cardstock to match your Designer Series Paper
10. Image stamp – think flowers, butterflies, etc.
11. Embossing Folder
12. Die Cutting Machine
13. Liquid Glue
14. Dimensionals
15. Embellishments
16. INKS

CLUE #2

Emboss one piece of Basic White that measures 4" x 5 1/4"

CLUE #3

Adhere the Embossed Basic White to the Colored Card base that measures 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" with Liquid Glue

CLUE #4

Add a second piece of Basic White that Measures 4" x 5 ¼" to the inside of the card with adhesive

CLUE #5

Add the ½" x 5 ¼" Cardstock to the right side of the Designer series paper that measures 1" x 5 ¼"

CLUE #6

Add both pieces from Clue #5 to the left side of the Basic White layer on the card front with Liquid Glue

CLUE #7

Stamp Sentiment on Basic White Scrap, punch out with circle punch

If you don't have circle punches, use your Paper Trimmer to cut it out.

CLUE #8

Create a Mat for your Sentiment layer with a larger punch, dies, or Paper Trimmer using the Colored Cardstock scrap.

Adhere sentiment and mat layers together with adhesive.

CLUE #9

Add a sentiment layer to the card front with Liquid glue or Dimensionals

CLUE #10

Does your card need an image? If yes, stamp on Basic White scrap and fussy cut it out, or use dies.

CLUE #11

Add the cut-out image to the card front with Dimensionals.

CLUE #12

Add embellishments!
