CLUE #1

1. Colored Cardstock – 8 ½” x 11”
 - a. Same Colored Cardstock 4” x 5 ¼”
 - b. May need scraps
2. Basic White Cardstock – (4) 4” x 5 ¼”
 - a. Scrap
3. Stamps
4. Ink
5. Paper Trimmer with a scoring blade
6. Embossing Folder
7. Die cutting machine
8. Embellishments
9. Adhesive – including Liquid Glue

CLUE #2

Make a diagonal cut with the Colored Cardstock 4” x 5 ¼” so that you have two pieces (see prop)

CLUE #3

Adhere the two cut pieces of colored cardstock to two pieces of Basic White – placing them so that one is Portrait and the other is Landscape

CLUE #4

Emboss the two cut pieces of Basic White/Colored cardstock with the Embossing Folder and die-cutting machine

CLUE #5

Cut the 8 ½” x 11” colored cardstock in half so that you have two card bases that are 4 ¼” x 11” or 8 ½” x 5 ½.” We are making two cards today! One portrait and one landscape

CLUE #6

Adhere the two embossed Basic White/Colored cardstock layers to the two card bases

CLUE #7

Stamp a greeting for both cards on the Basic White scraps, and use a paper trimmer to cut them down to size

CLUE #8

Create a Matt layer if desired, with colored cardstock scraps for the greetings

CLUE #9

Add one greeting to each card with Dimensionals

CLUE #10

Add embellishments to the card fronts

CLUE #11

Adhere the remaining two pieces of Basic White to the inside of both of the cards
