



## Mystery Monday Stamping

### CLUE #1

Gather your supplies to solve this week's mystery!

1. Basic White Thick Cardstock – 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½"
2. Basic White Cardstock – 4" x 5 ¼"
  - 2 ½" x 4"
  - scrap
3. Colored Cardstock – 2 ¾" x 4 ¼" (to coordinate with DSP)
4. Designer Series Paper (DSP) – 3 ¾" x 2"
5. Image stamps
6. Sentiment Stamps
7. Punches, Dies, Snips
8. Ink
9. Coloring tools, if your images need to be colored
10. Adhesive
11. Dimensionals
12. Ribbon
13. Embellishments if desired

### CLUE #2

Add Basic White 4" x 5 ¼" to card base with Dimensionals

### CLUE #3

Wrap ribbon horizontally across the Designer Series Paper, secure on back with adhesive.

I like to use Scotch tape for this!

### CLUE #4

Add DSP/Ribbon to the center of the Basic White Layer that is 4" x 5 ¼" with adhesive.

### CLUE #5

Stamp sentiment on Basic White Layer that measures 2 ½" x 4", set aside

### CLUE #6

Stamp 2-3 images on Basic White Scraps; if they need coloring, do that now.

### CLUE #7

Cut out stamped images with dies, punches or snips

### CLUE #8

Add stamped Basic White Layer that measures 2 ½" x 4" to colored cardstock layer that measures 2 ¾" x 4 ¼" with adhesive

### CLUE #9

Add cut-out images to the Basic White/Colored Cardstock layer that has your greeting on it. Add some with adhesive and others with Dimensionals

Optionally stamp background images before adhering die-cut elements.

You will be creating a cluster effect by overlapping the images

## CLUE #10

Add Basic White/Colored Cardstock layers to center of card with Dimensionals (centered over the ribbon/DSP panel)

## CLUE #11

Add Embellishments
