CLUE #1

- 1. Cardstock: 5 1/2" x 8 1/2"
 - a. Cardstock Same Color: 3" x 3"
- 2. Designer Series Paper (DSP) Different Patterns:
 - a. 1 3/4" x 5 3/8"
 - b. 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"
 - c. (2) 2 1/4" x 5 3/8"
 - d. scrap
- 3. Basic White: 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" (if you are using Colored Cardstock as base), Scrap
- 4. Stamps
- 5. Inks, including coloring tools if you need them
- 6. Punches, Dies, Snips
- 7. Adhesive including Dimensionals
- 8. Embellishments
- 9. Paper Trimmer with scoring tool

CLUE #2

Score Cardstock 5 ½" x 8 ½" at 1 7/8" and at 4 ¼"

CLUE #3

Use a Bone folder and give all score lines a good crease, creating a Z Fold

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CLUE#4

Adhere DSP 1 ¾" x 5 3/8" to front flap with adhesive

CLUE #5

Add one DSP 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 5 3/8" to the other portion of the front of the card with adhesive

CLUE #6

Add the second piece of DSP 2 %" x 5 3/8" to the inside of the card on the left panel with adhesive

CLUE #7

If your cardstock is colored cardstock, add Basic White 4 $1/8" \times 5 3/8"$ to the inside of the card on the right panel with adhesive

CLUE #8

Stamp greeting on Basic White scrap, die cut, punch or cut down with snips or paper trimmer.

CLUE 9

Adhere the 2 $7/8" \times 27/8"$ DSP to the 3" x 3" Cardstock with adhesive Don't glue your card shut.

CLUE #10

Use DSP scrap to create a mat for your greeting layer, and adhere both together with adhesive. Add to the card front with Dimensionals.

CLUE #11

If you wish to add an image to your card front, create that now by stamping and cutting out with punches, dies, or snips. Add with adhesive or Dimensionals

CLUE #12

Does your card need anything else like embellishments or ribbon? Add that now.
