CLUE #1 – Gather & Cut – Clues will be given for a Landscape card

Your finished card will be in landscape orientation, so pay attention to the direction of your DSP when cutting.

- Colored Cardstock – 4 1/4" x 8 1/4", score at 5 1/2"
- Same Colored Cardstock – 3" x 5 1/2"
- Same Colored Cardstock – 2 1/2" x 4 1/4"
- Basic White – 4" x 5 1/4"
- Basic White – 2 1/4" x 4"
- Basic White – scrap
- Designer Series Paper – 2 3/4" x 4 3/4"
- Designer Series Paper – 2 1/2" x 4"
- Stamps – images and greeting
- Ink
- Coloring tools, if needed
- Embellishments
- Paper Trimmer
- Adhesive, including Dimensionals

CLUE #2

Take the 3" x 5 1/2" piece of Colored Cardstock. Place the 5 1/2" side along the top of your Paper Trimmer and score at 1/2".

CLUE #3

Add adhesive to the 1/2" scored tab of the Colored Cardstock. Attach the tab to the back of the 4" x 5 1/4" Basic White layer, aligning the edges.

CLUE #4

Add adhesive to the back of the 4" x 5 1/4" Basic White layer, which now has the Colored Cardstock panel attached. Adhere it to the inside of the 4 1/4" x 8 1/4" card base.

CLUE #5

Add the 2 3/4" x 4 3/4" Designer Series Paper to the 3" x 5" front panel with adhesive.

CLUE #6

Add the 2 1/2" x 4" Designer Series Paper to the 2 3/4" x 4 1/4" flap of the card base, centering it with an even border.

CLUE #7

Take the 2 1/4" x 4" Basic White layer and stamp your greeting and images as desired. Color the images if needed.

You also have scrap Basic White available if you'd like to stamp, die cut or punch additional pieces for decorating your card.

CLUE #8

Adhere the stamped 2 1/4" x 4" Basic White layer to the 2 1/2" x 4 1/4" Colored Cardstock layer.

CLUE #9

Adhere the layered piece from Clue #8 to the 3" x 5" front panel of your card.

CLUE #10

Look at your card. Does it need embellishments? A bow? Maybe something else?

Add any finishing touches now.
