



Gather the supplies on Clue #1

Then, follow the remaining clues to make a card using your own supplies!

CLUE #1 – Your card can be Portrait or Landscape; these clues are for a Landscape card

1. Basic White Cardstock – 4 ¼" x 11", scored at 5 ½"
 - a. 5" x 3 ¾"
2. Colored Cardstock to match DSP – 5 ¼" x 4"
 - a. 1 ¾" x 3 ½"
 - b. 1 ¾" x 3"
3. Designer Series Paper – 1 ½" x 3 ¼"
 - a. 1 ½" x 2 ¾"
4. Scraps Basic White and Same Colored Cardstock as above
5. Stamps – Image and greeting
6. Ink Pad/coloring tools
7. Embossing Folder
8. Die Cutting Machine
9. Punches, Dies, Scissors, Paper Trimmer
10. Adhesive, including Liquid Glue, Dimensionals

CLUE #2

Use the Embossing Folder and emboss the Basic White cardstock layer with a die-cutting machine

CLUE #3

Adhere the Colored Cardstock that measures 5 ¼" x 4" to the Basic White card base with adhesive

CLUE #4

Add the Embossed Basic White Layer to the card front with Liquid Glue

CLUE #5

Add the Colored Cardstock 1 ¾" x 3 ½" to the card front with Liquid Glue, leaving about ¼" from the edge of the Basic White layer. Suggestion: Add to the left side of the card front if the card is landscape or to the top if it's a portrait.

CLUE #6

Add DSP that measures 1 ½" x 3 ¼" to the Colored cardstock in Clue #5

CLUE #7

Add the Colored Cardstock 1 ¾" x 3" to the card front, overlapping the previous Cardstock/DSP layer with Dimensionals.

Adhere the DSP that measures 1 ½" x 2 ¾" to the Colored cardstock with adhesive

CLUE #8

Stamp greeting on Basic White scrap; use punches, dies, snips or trimmer to cut to size

CLUE #9

Make a Matt layer for your greeting with the colored cardstock scrap, and adhere the two together

CLUE #10

Add a greeting/Matt layer to the card front with Dimensionals

CLUE #11

If your card needs an image, create one now. Either stamp an image or use dies or punches to cut it out. Or fussy-cut an image with snips. Add to the card front.

CLUE #12

Add Embellishments
